SECTIONS: K-2, K-4, K-6, K-12/Adult

The older player on a team determines the section placement.

For example, a team consisting of a second grader and a third grader is eligible to play in K-4 or higher.

FORMAT & RULES:

Four round Swiss. Each round consists of two matches with opposing team.

All ages welcome, even adults.

Time control is G/5 (game in 5 min for each per player).

USCF rules, 6th edition. NWSRS rated.

AWARDS: Trophies for top teams in each section. Two trophies per team.

Award ceremony immediately after the tournament.
